Directors Tucker and Barth and Sicke provided a brief update on the discussion of the September 23, 2022 Outreach Committee meeting, which was a kick-off meeting for the phase two process with LWA and outreach facilitator Kim Floyd. The District intends to host a "focus group" meeting with water customers to discuss the proposed approach for revising the District's funding mechanism.

### **BACKGROUND:**

At the August 2, 2022 Board of Directors meeting, the District authorized Larsen, Wurzel & Associates (LWA) to proceed with a cost-of-service study, engineer's report, and associated outreach effort to implement an alternative funding mechanism in 2023. On October 11, 2022, the District's Outreach Committee met with LWA and outreach facilitator Kim Floyd to plan Phase 2 activities and to formalize the outreach program components.
