Dear Water Customer:

We are looking forward to another unallocated irrigation season. As of today, the Yolo County Flood Control and Water Conservation District's (District) total stored water supply is approximately 427,000 acre-feet. With the completion of canal system repairs and critical capital projects, we are prepared to start the 2024 irrigation season and anticipate increasing diversions in the Winters and West Adams Canals starting Wednesday, April 24.

For your reference, the 2024 Ditchtenders' phone numbers, and ditch ride numbers and canal map are attached. We encourage you to place your water orders directly through your Ditchtender, or if you are unsure of which Ditchtender is on duty, please call 530.662.1037 to be connected to the Ditchtender on duty.

Additionally, for those of you interested in ordering water and managing your account online, please see the attached setup instructions for creating an account at <u>vcfc.waterui.com</u>.

Lastly, we apologize in advance for any inconvenience, but the <u>irrigation season is expected</u> to end on Monday, September 30 as we prepare for and complete the Capay Dam Bladder Replacement Project prior to the rainy season.
