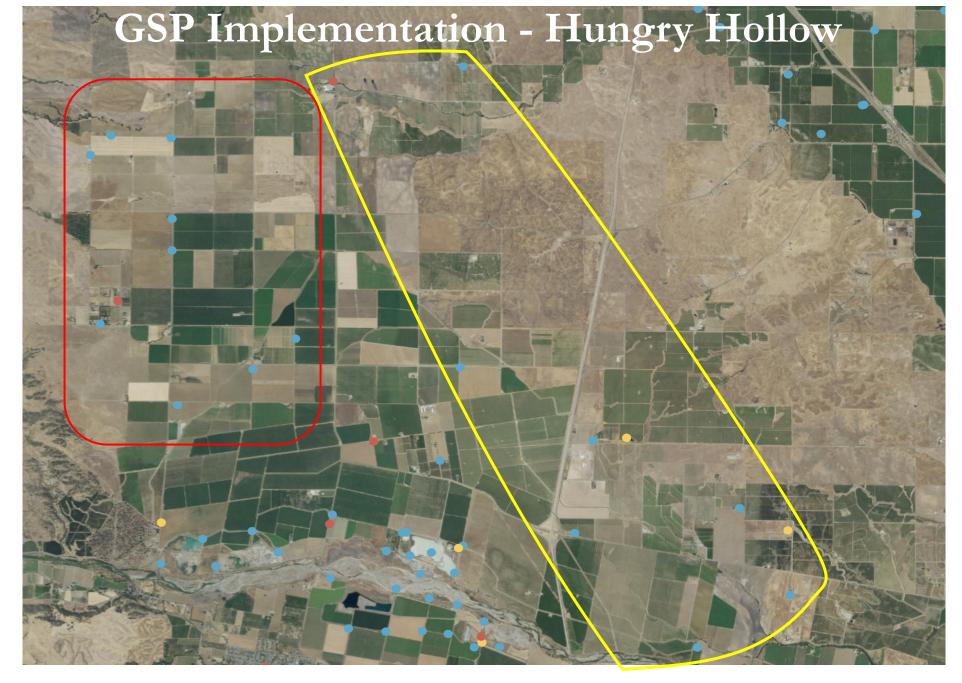
HUC 12 Watersheds SGA Model Catchments - Creeks - Canals

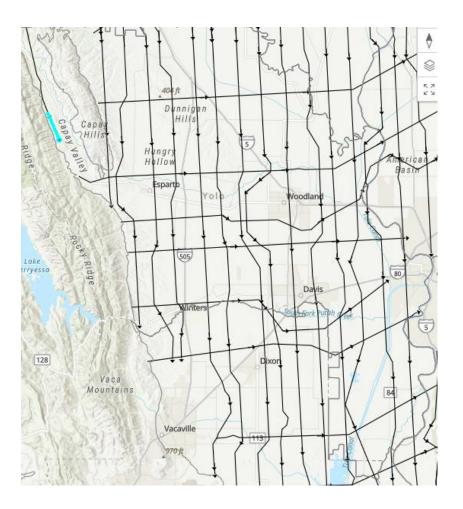


Hungry Hollow Groundwater Working Group Update

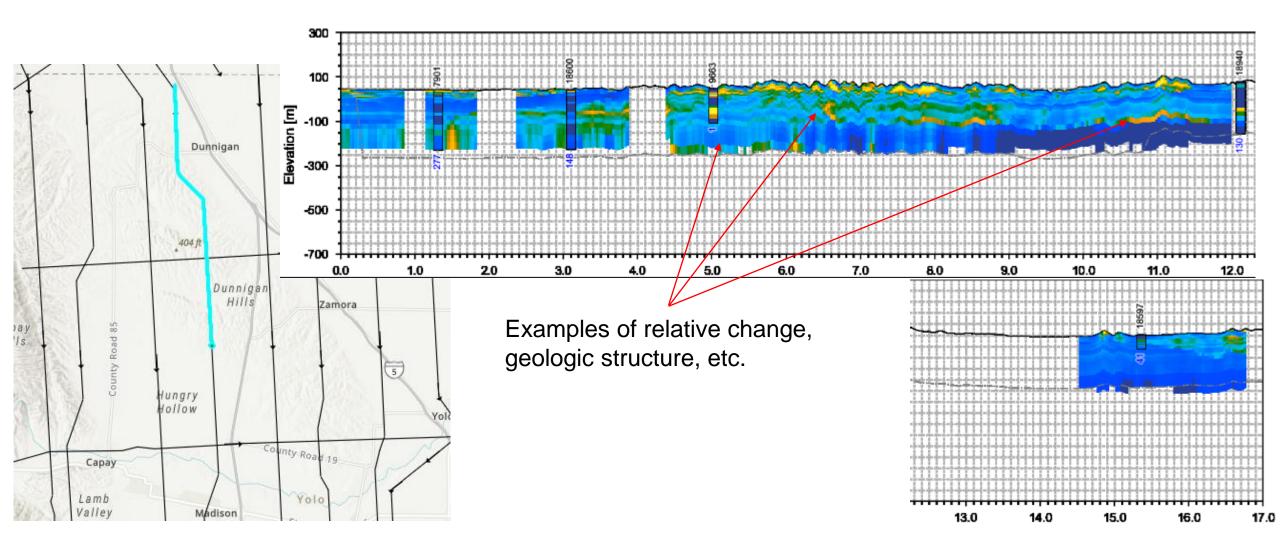
- YSGA staff updating well log database and will
 - develop geologic/hydrogeologic cross sections
 - assist SEI with updating the aquifer parameters for the model
 - identify PMAs based on updated hydrogeologic conceptual understanding of Hungry Hollow
 - collaborate with Hungry Hollow Groundwater Working Group find a path to sustainability
- Exploring other opportunities to collect additional geophysical data (tTEM, SP) to fill in data gaps where AEM and/or well log coverage isn't available

Airborne Electromagnetic (AEM) Survey Data in Yolo

- "X-ray" of the subsurface along flight lines up to 1,000 feet deep
- Generally, data provides *relative* accuracy
 - where coarser v. finer grained material are relative to one another
 - where saline v. fresh water zones are relative to one another
 - subsurface structure (folding, layering) and faulting

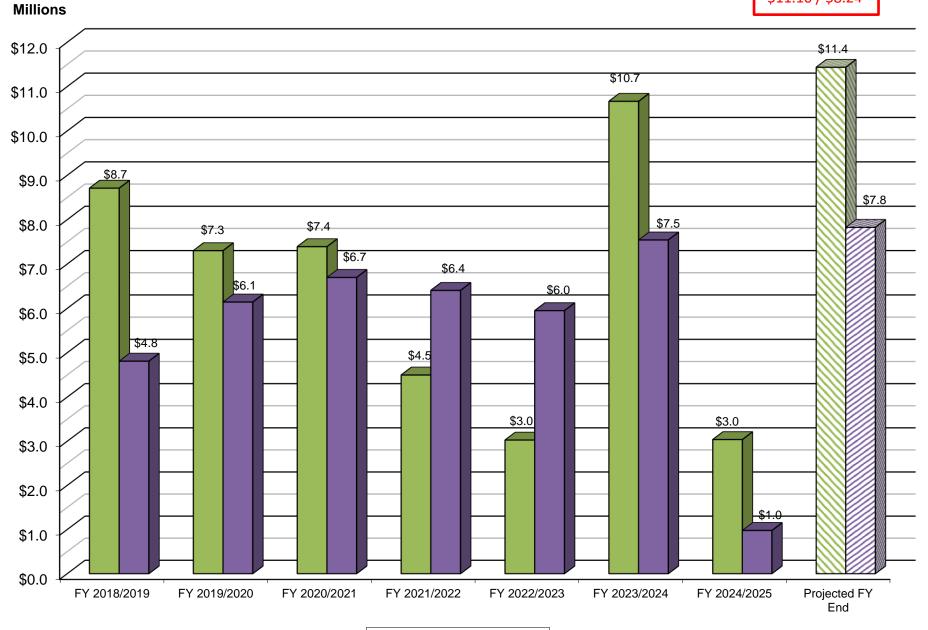

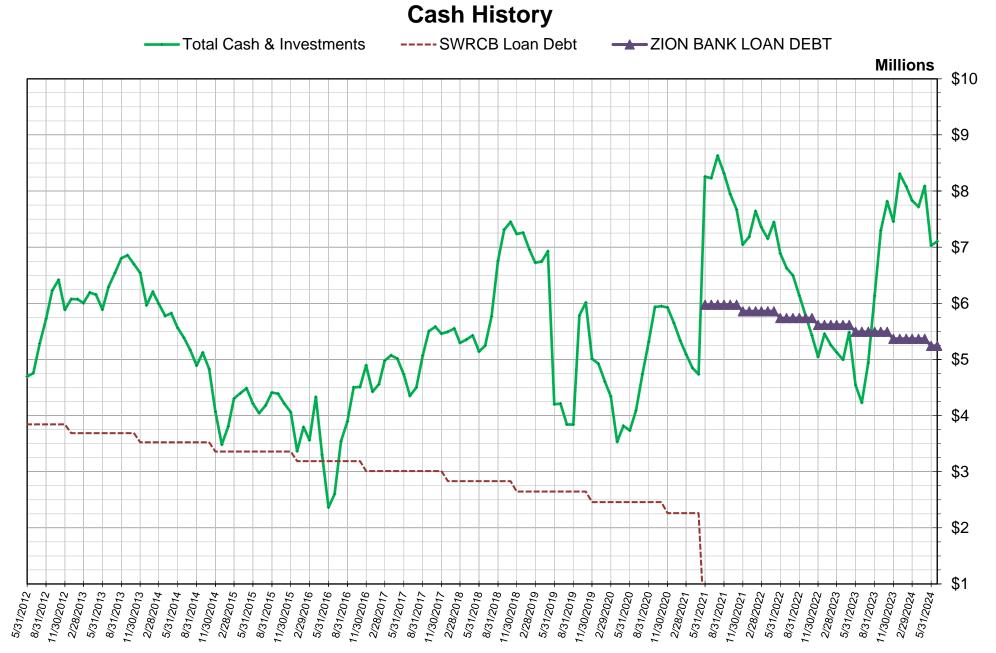
