2. OPEN FORUM

Duane Chamberlain inquired about the District's involvement in weed control along the County's roadside ditches because the ditches on County Road 29 near his property need cleaning. Sicke confirmed the District is assisting the County in spraying and cleaning the roadside ditches at the end of the irrigation season, and Sicke informed Chamberlain that O&M Supervisor Espinoza would call him with additional details.

3. CONSIDERATION: Adding Items to the Posted Agenda

4. <u>CONSIDERATION: Adopt Resolution 24.05 Requesting Collection of Charges on Tax Roll</u>

General Manager Kristin Sicke and Assistant General Manager Erik Cadaret presented updates on the YSGA SGMA Implementation Grant funding projects. Directors asked clarifying questions related to the projects and data involved.

Directors Tucker and Barth reported on attending the YSGA's July Board of Directors meeting and a District committee meeting to discuss the contract with the Geysers and LACOSAN. Barth also reported on connecting with the facilitator for the Hungry Hollow Groundwater Working Group. Director Vink had nothing to report. Chair Mayer reported on participating in the District's strategic planning committee meeting and a NCWA Board meeting.

8. GENERAL DISCUSSION

Director Tucker inquired whether there were any updates on the FERC inspections related to the Part 12D Comprehensive Assessment. General Manager Sicke reported that discussions with FERC included repair or replacement of Indian Valley Dam's 60" Hollow Jet Valve, which is the low-level outlet works that regulates outflow from the reservoir. Additionally, the FERC Part 12D Comprehensive Assessment workshops have resulted in hundreds of potential failure modes that will be prioritized by risk and the financial impact will be evaluated and presented to the Board at a later meeting.

Lee Smith requested the District share a high-level summary of the proposed <u>Sacramento/Bay-Delta Update to the Bay-Delta Plan</u> and the District's alternative solution for the <u>Healthy Rivers</u> and <u>Landscapes Program</u>. Chair Mayer and Sicke provided a high-level overview of what has recently transpired with the Bay-Delta Plan amendments and the District's proposal to recharge winter water and provide flow contributions to Putah Creek for the benefit of salmon restoration.

Duane Chamberlain commented how measuring standing water levels in groundwater wells is not consistent with determining how the aquifer reacts to pump operations. Sicke agreed with Chamberlain and requested that Assistant General Manager Cadaret follow up with Chamberlain to learn more about any available operational data.

BACKGROUND:

The Center for Land-Based Learning partnered with Yolo County RCD, Community Alliance with Family Farmers, Yolo Subbasin Groundwater Agency and the Hungry Hollow Groundwater Committee, Carbon Cycle Institute, Yolo County Health and Human Services, UC Davis, Good Humus Produce, and Yolo County Flood Control & Water Conservation District to submit a \$300,000 grant application to Capital Region Creative Corps. The proposal included the creation of short videos on the role of agriculture in mitigating climate change impacts and managing groundwater sustainability, also known as Farming for Our Future: Solutions from the Fields. The videos include participation and demonstrations by local farmers, water managers, and various stakeholders.
